Heads-up - the 'nvidia-580xx-dkms' from the AUR currently doesn't work with the LTS 6.12.66-1 (and older) kernel - there is a note on <https://aur.archlinux.org/packages/nvidia-580xx-utils> about this from a few days back. I just found this out the hard way. Rather than roll back, I decided the easiest way forward was to install 6.18.6-arch1-1 alongside the LTS and run a grub-mkconfig to make it available as a fall-back until this gets fixed, and all is now well, but be aware of this if you're running an LTS kernel.
